

## Adult Covenant

As a participant, I agree to covenant with everyone else to abide by the following regulations:

- 1. All youth and adults are expected to abide by the schedule and attend all group meetings, work times, and worship experiences. Supervision of the youth from your church is **your** responsibility.
- As guests of Trinity UMC, area churches, and work sites, we expect everyone to respect all buildings, equipment, and property by refraining from intentionally causing harm. <u>Furniture cannot</u> <u>be moved, rearranged or removed from any room</u>.
- 3. We expect everyone to honor the lights out and quiet times designated by the leaders, including the adult volunteers. Adults staying on campus cannot leave campus after lights out. Enforcing the lights out policy with your youth is **your** responsibility.
- 4. Since there are separate sleeping areas for boys and girls, the areas of the opposite sex are offlimits at all times. Weekend of the Cross Staff reserves the right to enter any room for any reason.
- 5. The possession or use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, or firearms is not permitted and will not be tolerated. The use or possession of any of these items will result in an early trip home. Since our accommodations are on school property, the use or possession of some of these items are illegal, and may result in an arrest as well.
- 6. The use of any prescription drugs, by youth, must be reported to the director of the Weekend of the Cross and your church group leader before the weekend of the event.
- Transportation will be provided to all activities by designated adults once participants are registered at Centenary on Thursday evening. No youth will be allowed to drive any vehicle during the weekend. <u>You</u> are responsible for ensuring that all youth assigned to your work team are transported to Trinity UMC and your worksite.
- 8. All meals will be provided by Weekend of the Cross. You will not be allowed to leave the campus or your worksite to obtain meals, snacks or drinks. Do not order food to be delivered.
- 9. No outside youth will be allowed at any Weekend of the Cross event, worksite or facility.
- 10. Shirts with sleeves, and closed-toe shoes are to be worn on the work sites. <u>No</u> short shorts, sleeveless shirts, or open-toe shoes (flip-flops or sandals) on the sites. All shirts must cover your mid-riff. No clothes with inappropriate content will be allowed at the worksite or campus.
- 11. Above all, remember to respect each person we come in contact with during the weekend. We represent our home churches and Weekend of the Cross to the community. We strive to be a Christ-like presence to others.
